A PERMIT FROM THE CITY IS REQUIRED, PRIOR to installation of Monuments and Markers, at the cost of \$15.00.

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Cemetery Decoration Rules

Guidelines for flowers, keepsakes, and other gravesite items

Purpose: These rules help keep the cemetery safe, peaceful, respectful, and accessible for every family.

- Flowers may be placed only in approved, non-breakable containers.
- Glass containers, jars, and other breakable items are prohibited.
- Decorations must remain within the designated grave or monument area.
- Artificial flowers and seasonal decorations are permitted when kept neat and in good condition.
- Fences, borders, rocks, gravel, mulch, and permanent plantings require prior approval.
- Toys, balloons, flags, photographs, solar lights, and personal keepsakes may be removed if they interfere with mowing or maintenance.
- Food, beverages, alcohol, open-flame candles, and hazardous materials are prohibited.
- Trees, shrubs, and flowers may not be planted.
- Faded flowers, damaged decorations, and unauthorized items may be removed by cemetery staff.
- Seasonal and holiday decorations must be removed within 30 days after the holiday.
- All items must be secured safely and must not create a hazard for visitors or workers.
- The cemetery is not responsible for items that are lost, stolen, damaged, or removed.
